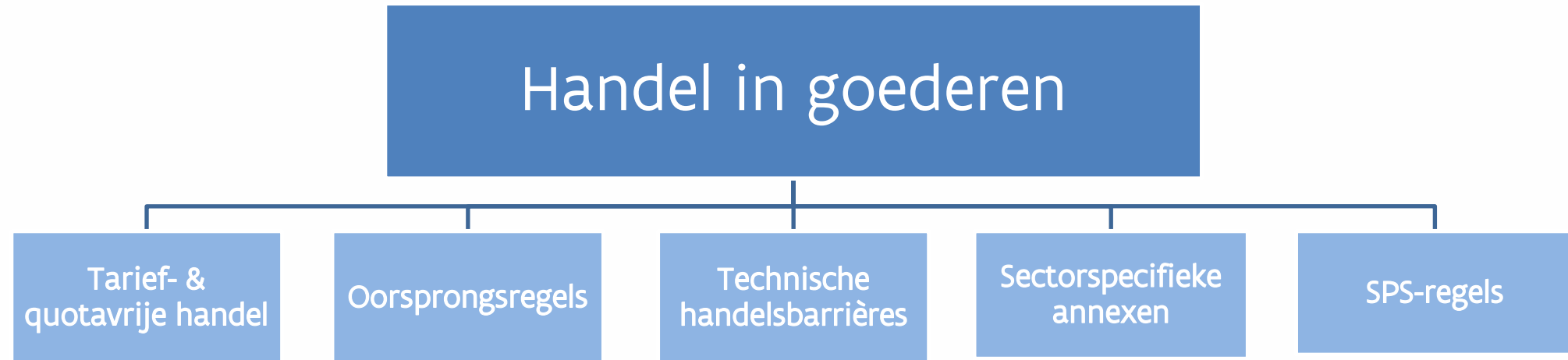
EU-VK Handels- en Samenwerkingsakkoord

Context

- EU-VK Handels- en Samenwerkingsakkoord trad vanaf 1 januari 2021 in werking
- Evaluatie akkoord is globaal positief
- Garanties dat er op een open en faire manier handel gedreven zal worden
- Beide partijen zullen bepaalde onderdelen van het akkoord nu verder uitwerken in allerlei werkgroepen
- Afwenden 'no deal' belangrijk om economische schade te beperken



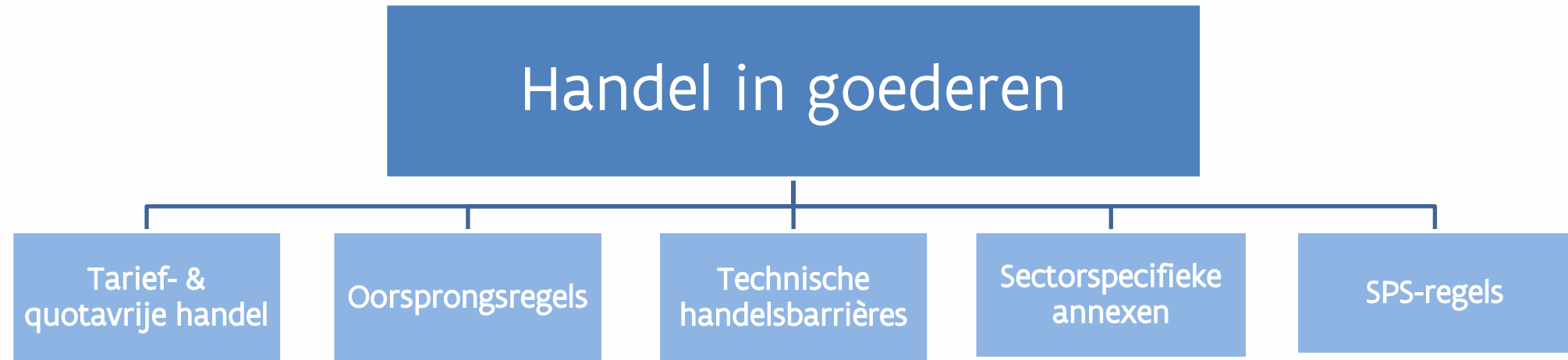
EU-VK Handels- en Samenwerkingsakkoord



Tarief- en quotavrije handel

- Akkoord voorziet in volledige tarief liberalisering. Belangrijke verworvenheid en unicum.
- In geval van 'no deal' zou er sprake zijn geweest van tarieven die konden oplopen tot 40% wat onze export naar het VK ernstig zou verstoren.
- Aantal minieme quota's op aluminiumproducten en tonijn.

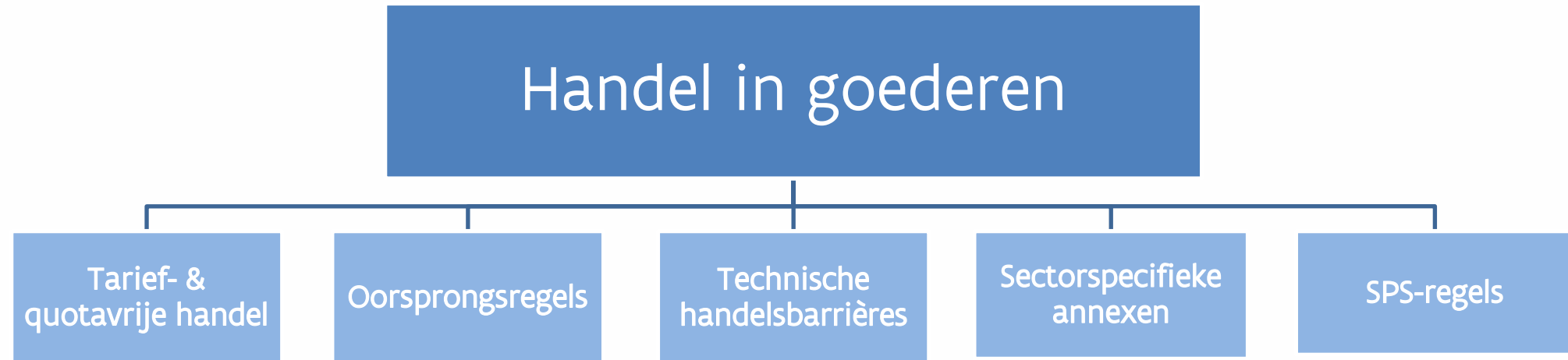

Oorsprongsregels

- ! Caveat ! Enkel tariefvrije toegang tot elkaars markten mits bewijs dat product voldoet aan oorsprongsregels die zijn opgenomen in het akkoord.

SPS-regels

- Elke partij behoudt zich recht voor om zelf de voedselveiligheidsstandaarden vast te stellen m.b.t. producten van plantaardige en dierlijke oorsprong.
- Afspraken om te vermijden dat praktijken vermomde niet-tarifaire belemmeringen zijn.
- Geen voorafgaande inspectie nodig voor 'listed entities'.
- Beide partijen erkennen elkaars regelgeving inzake biologische productie als equivalent.

Import from UK

- Same import rules as for other 'third countries'
 - Health certificate, phytosanitary certificate
 - Notification of consignment in TRACES by the importer
 - Import checks (documentary, identity, physical) in designated BCP
 - CHED

Import from UK: first findings (01/01/21 – 13/07/21)

○ Animal products

- 3045 notified consignments
- 94% through BCP Zeebrugge
- Mostly ABP (animal fat for technical use)
- 5% non compliant (mostly documents)

○ Plants and plant products

- 236 notified consignments
- 90% seeds
- Mostly through BCP Zaventem
- 30% non compliant (mostly documents)



Import from UK: first findings (01/01/21 – 13/07/21)

○ Animals

- 14 notified consignments
- Mostly horses through BCP Liège
- 1 non compliant (documents)

○ HRFNOA

- 7 notified consignments
- 2 non compliant (documents)

- Import and export requirements are discussed between European Commission and UK – no bilateral contacts between member states and UK

Export to UK: animals and (high-priority) plants and plant products

- Health certificate or phytosanitary certificate and pre-notification since 1 January 2021
 - Instructions published on FASFC website!
- Phytosanitary requirements
 - Intensive discussions with sector associations and other member states and clarifications from UK authorities in order to comply with phytosanitary requirements and to limit the burden for trade.
 - Table with information on the presence of quarantine organisms established in collaboration with NL, DK, PL
 - Extra inspections during growing season might be needed for certain host plants
 - Instructions published on FASFC website!



○ Definitions

- POAO = Products Of Animal Origin (human consumption)
- ABP = Animal By-Products (not for human consumption)

○ POAO & ABP: health certificate and inspections at designated Border Control Posts (BCP) from 1 July 2022 onwards!

- Exporter needs to comply with UK requirements
- Make sure that you follow the instructions that are published on the FASFC website
- Be prepared!
- Pre-notification in IPAFFS by British importer from 1 January 2022 onwards

Export to UK: composite products (examples)

- Pizza made in Belgium with Italian salami and French cheese
 - Point 1.7: BE (produced in Belgium)
 - Salami: producer must be (EU) approved, minimal treatment A is sufficient, origin can be traced back by identification mark, ingredients (pork only: POR) are mentioned on commercial document. No animal health restrictions for pork ingredients (IT-1). REMARK: salami can not originate from Sardinia, since treatment C would be required (heat treatment of at least 80°C throughout the product, which is not possible)
 - Cheese: France (origin: FR) is approved by UK and producer must be (EU) approved, thermal treatment (pasteurization is sufficient) and animal species (milk from cows) are mentioned on commercial documents



Export to UK: composite products (examples)

- Lasagna made with minced meat (pork/beef, spices) from Belgium, cheese from Italy and UHT milk from the Netherlands
 - No (animal health) restrictions for Belgium; producer of lasagne must have (EU) approval (BXXX, meat products); minimal treatment A; option E1 for BSE
 - Belgian producer of minced meat must be approved; no animal health restrictions for Belgium (BE-0); animal species (pork/beef) needs to be mentioned on label or commercial documents (POR, BOV in health certificate)
 - Cheese: No (animal health) restrictions for Italy (IT); producer must have an (EU) approval; necessary information must be delivered to Belgian establishment by supplier
 - Milk: No (animal health) restrictions for the Netherlands (NL); producer must have an (EU) approval; necessary information must be delivered to Belgian establishment by supplier

- Confectionery made by a Belgian company with gelatin from Germany
- Exemption: no health certificate is required

Export to UK: meat products (example)

- 'Frikandel/currywurst' made with MDM from a Belgian producer who sources its raw materials from suppliers in Belgium and France



- Meat product that is cooked and delivered frozen to UK retail client
- Producer of the meat product must be (EU) approved as well as his supplier of MDM and the slaughterhouses the raw materials for the production of MDM are sourced from
- Producer of MDM must provide his client with information on the origin of the poultry the MDM is made from (necessary to evaluate animal health requirements in the health certificate)

Export to UK: dairy products (example)

- Yoghurt with strawberry, produced in Belgium (BE) with german (DE) milk.
 - GN-code 0403:health certificate model HTB
 - The Belgian producer must be (EU) approved.
 - Verification of animal health status with regard to rinderpest and FMD via OIE-website (certifying officer at the moment of certification) based on traceability information of the milk from Belgian producer.
 - Minimal heat treatment is pasteurization; product can not be labeled as 'based on raw milk'.



Export to UK: all regulated plant and plant products

- Pre-notification in IPAFFS by British importer from 1 January 2022 onwards
- Phytosanitary certificate needed from 1 July 2022 onwards
- Inspections in designated Border Control Posts (BCP) from 1 July onwards
- Includes fruit and vegetables (some fruits are exempted) – instructions will be published on FASFC website



Export to UK: electronic certification

- BECERT = FASFC IT application for the electronic application and issuing of health or phytosanitary certificates
- For the time being only results in paper certificates
- Development of an API (application processing interface) to connect with TRACES NT and other applications of third countries, which will enable electronic certification (instead of paper certificates)
- Future electronic certification linked with the UK system through TRACES NT and the ePhyto HUB (plants and plant products)



- **Be prepared!** Consult the instructions on the FASFC website and the information from the UK: which certificate and how to comply with the UK requirements
- Contact your importer or your FASFC local control unit in case of questions
- Apply for a certificate at least 24 hours in advance
- More flexible arrangements might be possible if you discuss this timely with your local control unit and if this is feasible on an organizational level

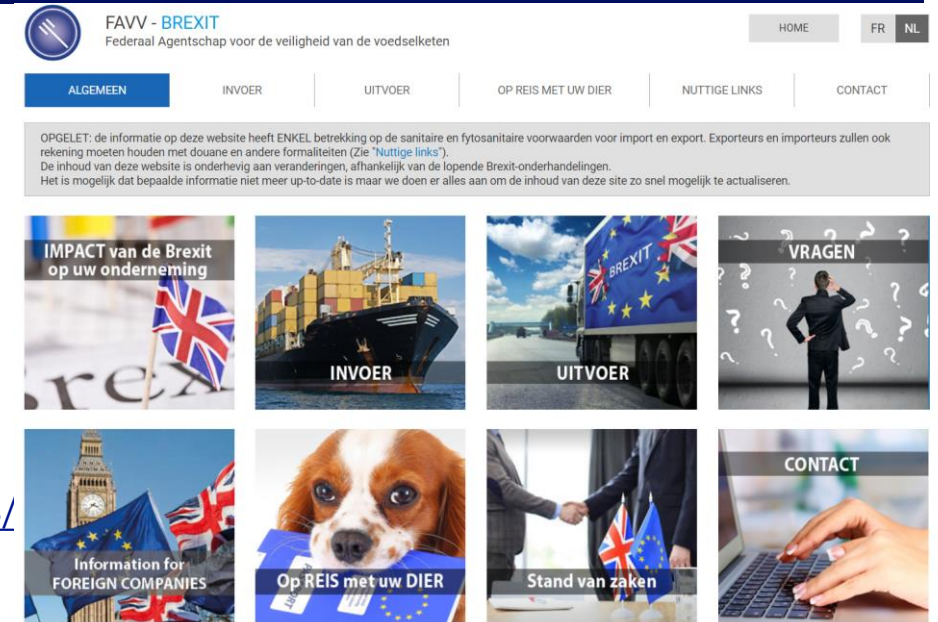

On 14 September 2021, UK government announced the following changes to import controls for SPS goods

1 January 2022

- The requirement for pre-notification of agri-food imports will be introduced on 1 January 2022 as opposed to 1 October 2021.

1 July 2022

- The requirement for Export Health Certificates will be introduced, and physical checks on SPS goods will take place at Border Control Posts, as of 1 July 2022 as opposed to 1 January 2022.

Some changes have already come into force. These apply to:

- **Products of Animal Origin under safeguard measures.** You can find more information [here](#).
- **Live Animals.** You can find out more information [here](#).
- **High priority plants and plant products.** You can find a list of those affected here. A list of high-priority plants and plant products can be found [here](#).

How do I obtain an Export Health Certificate (EHC)?

Should the following process change, Defra will update gov.uk.

1. The **EU exporter is responsible for obtaining the Export Health Certificate**. They must contact the competent authority in their country to arrange for a certifying officer to be allocated to inspect the goods
2. The certifying officer(s) reviews the consignment and, if it meets the requirements, issues the EHC
3. The **EU exporter** must send an electronic copy of the health certificate to their importer in Great Britain
4. The GB importer must upload the electronic copy of the certificate to IPAFFS as part of the pre-notification process

Export Health Certificates

- Export Health Certificates will be issued to the EU exporter by the competent authority of the Member State you are exporting from.
- Model Export Health Certificates are available [here](#) for a wide range of commodities. These are examples.

- If there is no import licence, you should complete an [IV58 form](#) on gov.uk and email a completed version to imports@apha.gov.uk

What is a Phytosanitary Certificate?

To export regulated plants and plant products from the EU to Great Britain, you must obtain a phytosanitary certificate for each consignment from the plant health authority in the country where your supplier is based.

A phytosanitary certificate is a statement from the plant health authority that the consignment:

- has been officially inspected
- complies with legal requirements for entry into Great Britain
- is free from quarantine pests and diseases

The inspection referred to in the phytosanitary certificate must take place no more than 14 days before the consignment is dispatched from the country where your supplier is.

You will need to upload a copy of the phytosanitary certificate on the import IT system PEACH if you need to pre-notify your consignment.

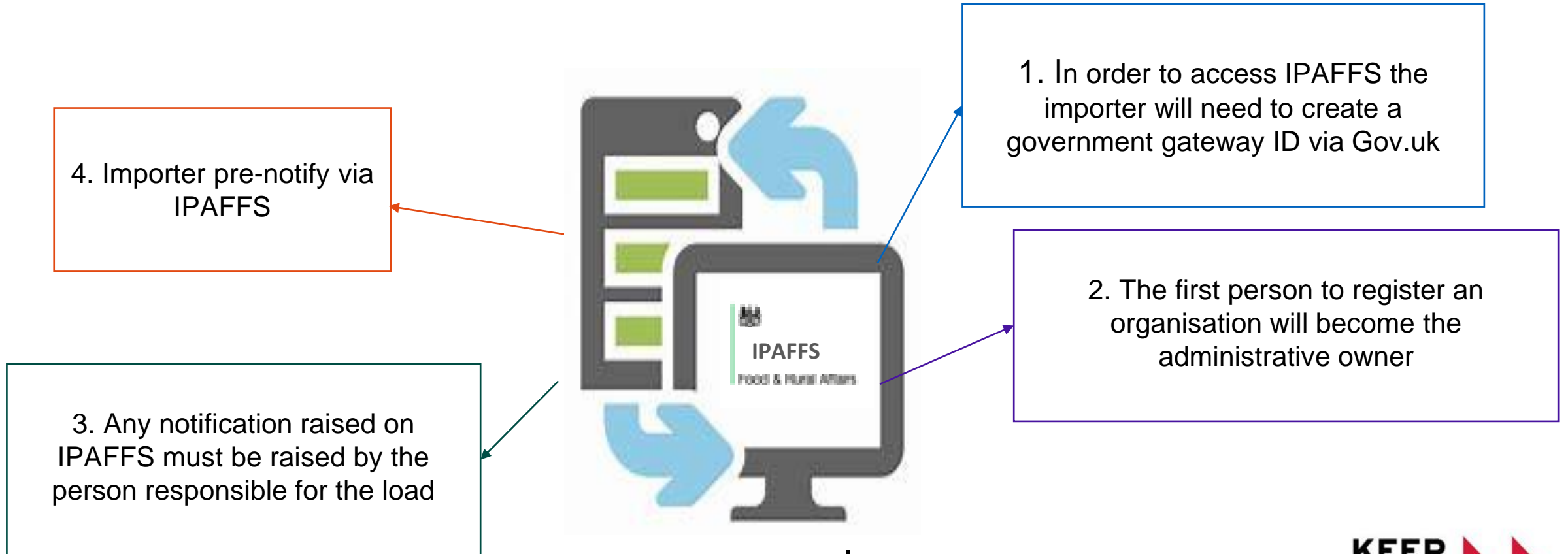

Importer Pre-Notification Process - IPAFFS

IPAFFS is Great Britain's system for GB importers to pre-notify the arrival of SPS goods



What information does the GB importer need to submit an IPAFFS pre-notification?

- The product that is being imported
- The date that it will be imported into Great Britain
- Which country the imported product is coming from
- The place of destination of the consignment

Composite Products

Overview: Composite products are food containing both **processed** Products of Animal Origin (POAO) and products of plant origin, e.g. a ready-meal lasagne

Composite products must follow the phased requirements for Products of Animal Origin unless otherwise exempt.

Some goods are exempt if they:

- contain less than 50% processed animal product;
- contain no meat product; and
- meet the requirements in Article 6 of Decision 2007/275.

‘Groupage’ is the commercial grouping of multiple consignments within a single sealed trailer or container. For example:

- **Mixed consignment:** multiple product lines of the same commodity type (e.g. composite products) are grouped under a single export health certificate and imported as a single consignment
- **Multiple quantities of the same commodity:** (e.g. fish products) potentially from several sources are grouped into the same container. It may be possible to import these as a single consignment covered by a single health certificate or as a mixed load (containing several consignments)
- **Mixed load:** multiple different commodity types (e.g. dairy products and meat products) grouped in a single container
- There are four models that have been developed for importing groupage loads from the European Union into Great Britain. [A video and further guidance on these models can be found here.](#)
 - A. Consolidation Hub
 - B. Sequential / Single
 - C. Linear / Multiple Pallet
 - D. Hybrid Approach

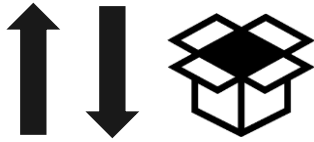

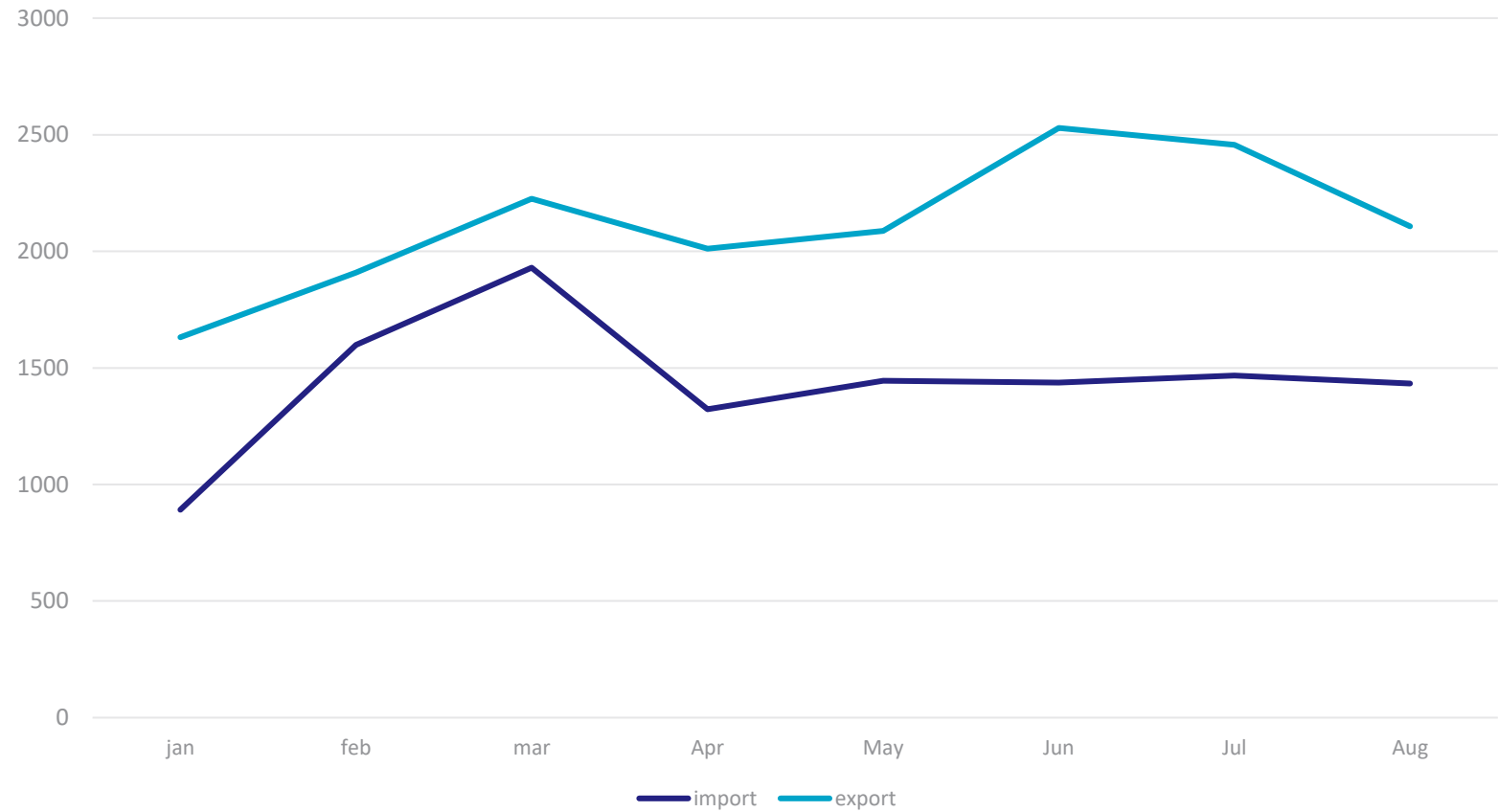

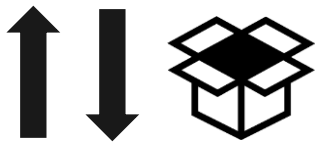
EVOLUTIE HANDEL

Value of trade (x million EUR)



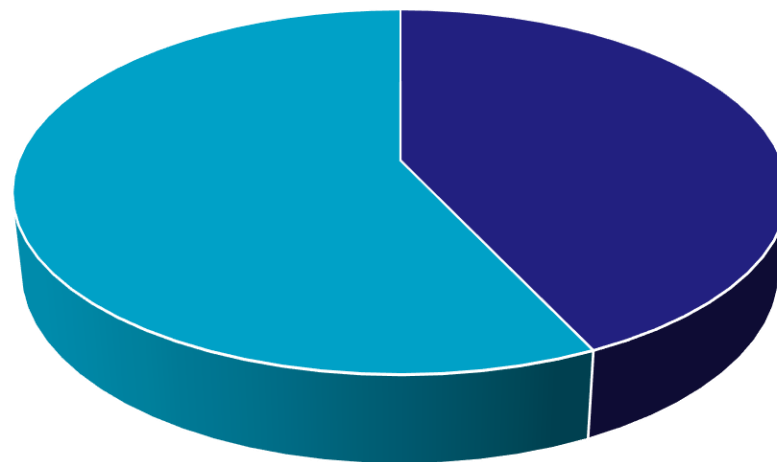

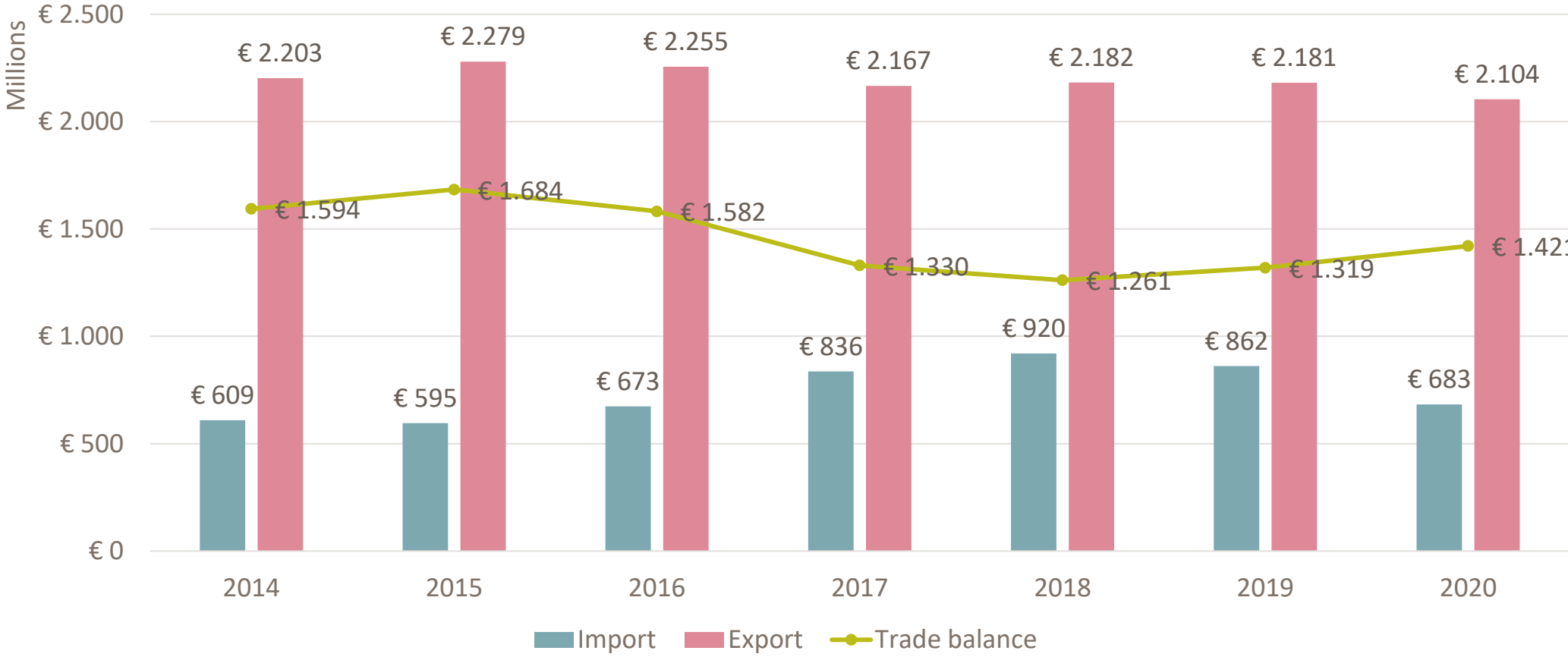

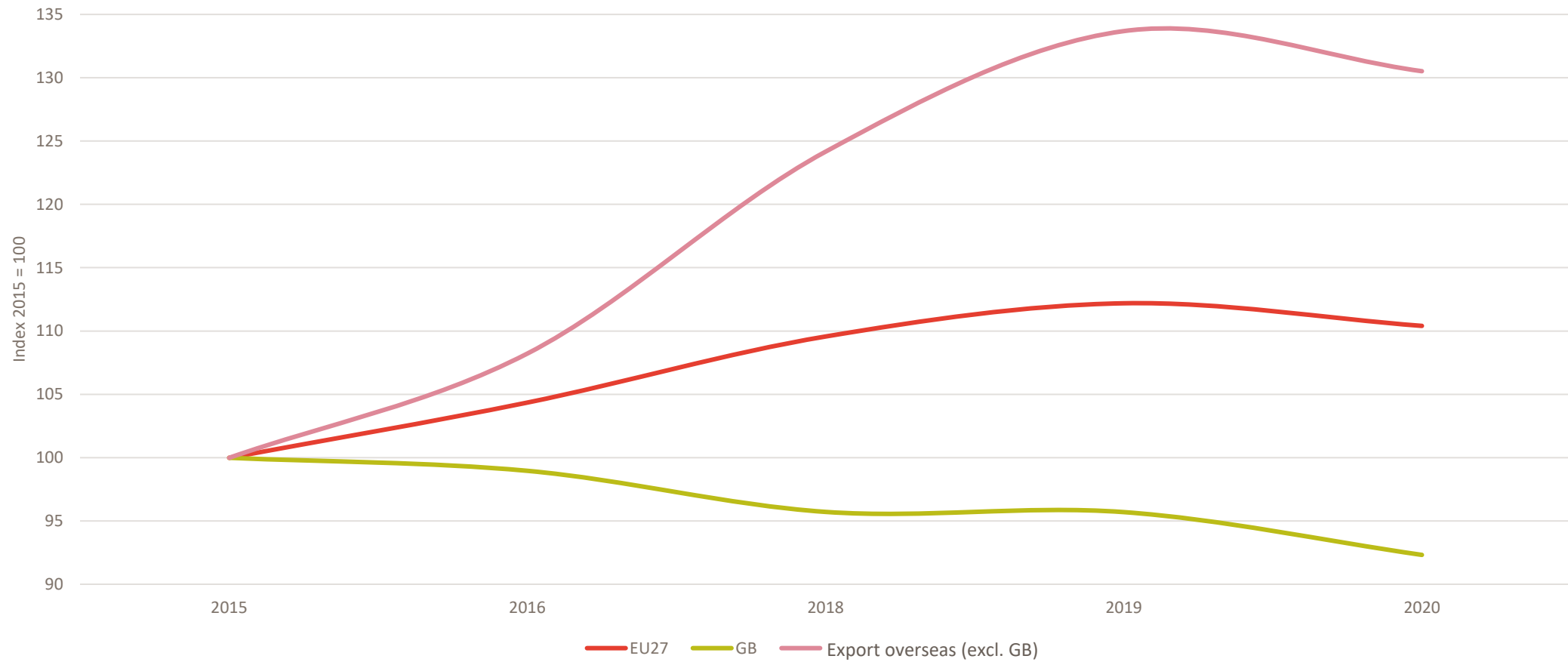
VK nu eerste exportmarkt buiten de EU



Evolutie handel BE-UK 2015-2020

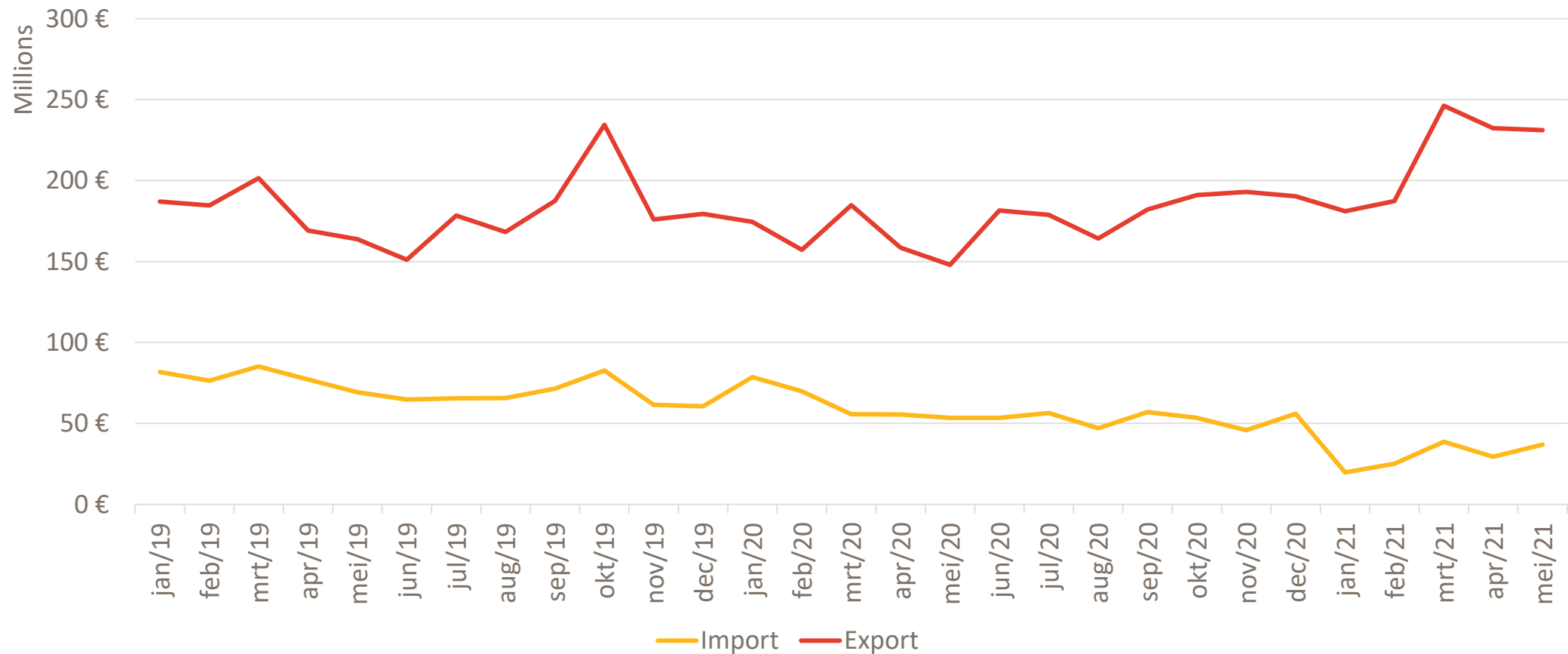


Evolutie export naar VK tav EU27 en verre export 2015-2020

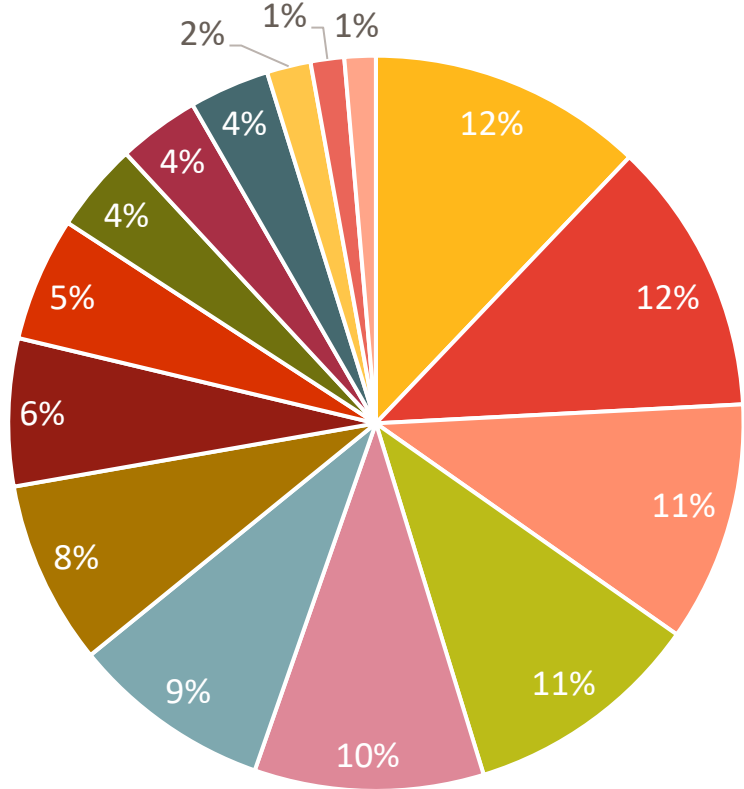


Sterke daling van invoer in januari 2021

Sterke stijging van uitvoer in maart 2021

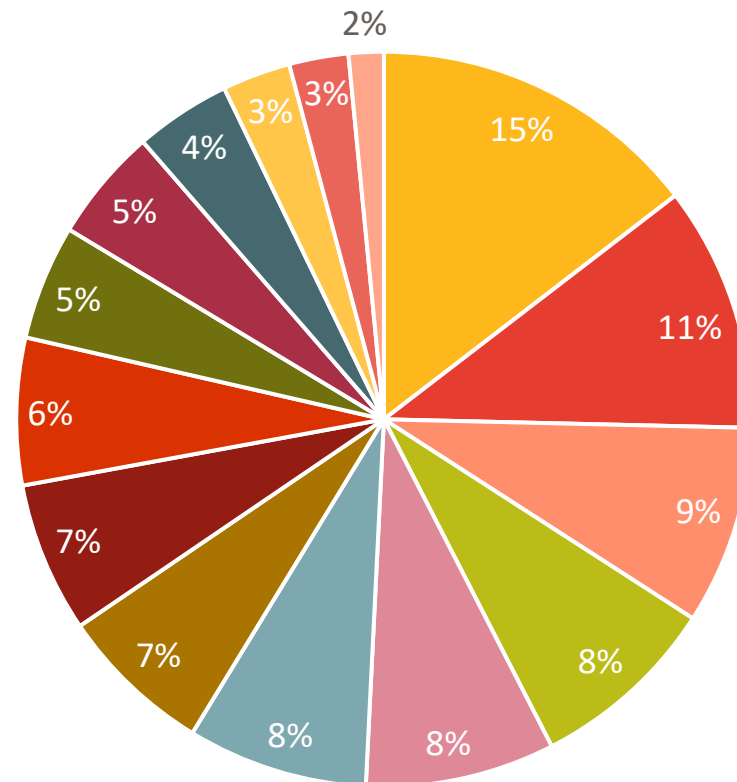


Export naar VK per productgroep 2020

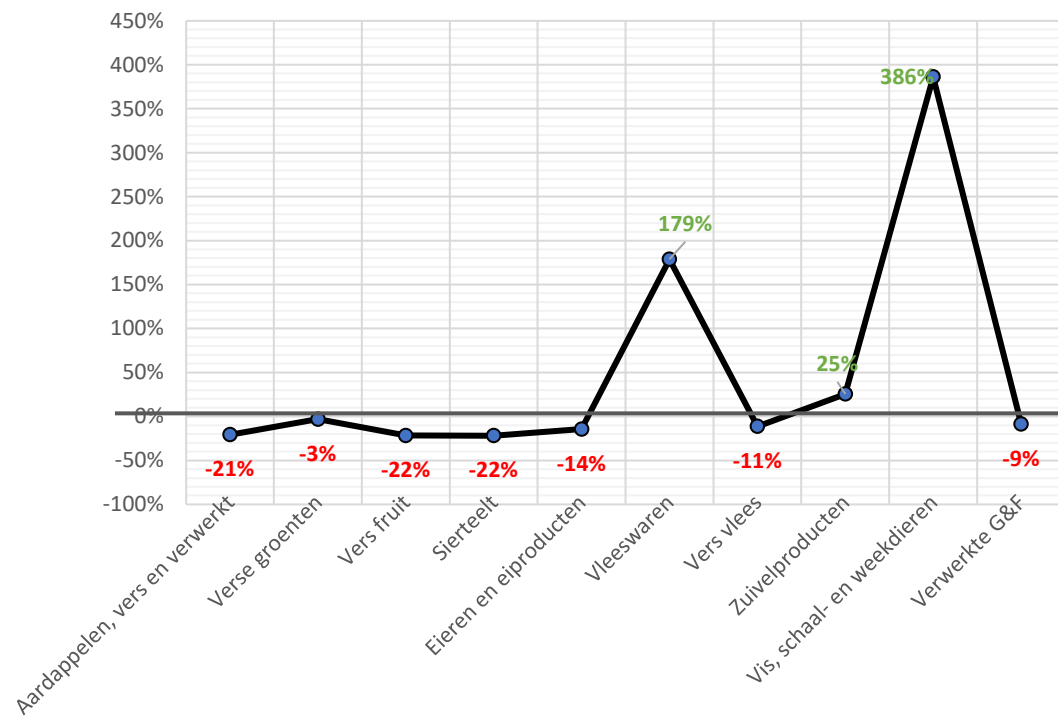

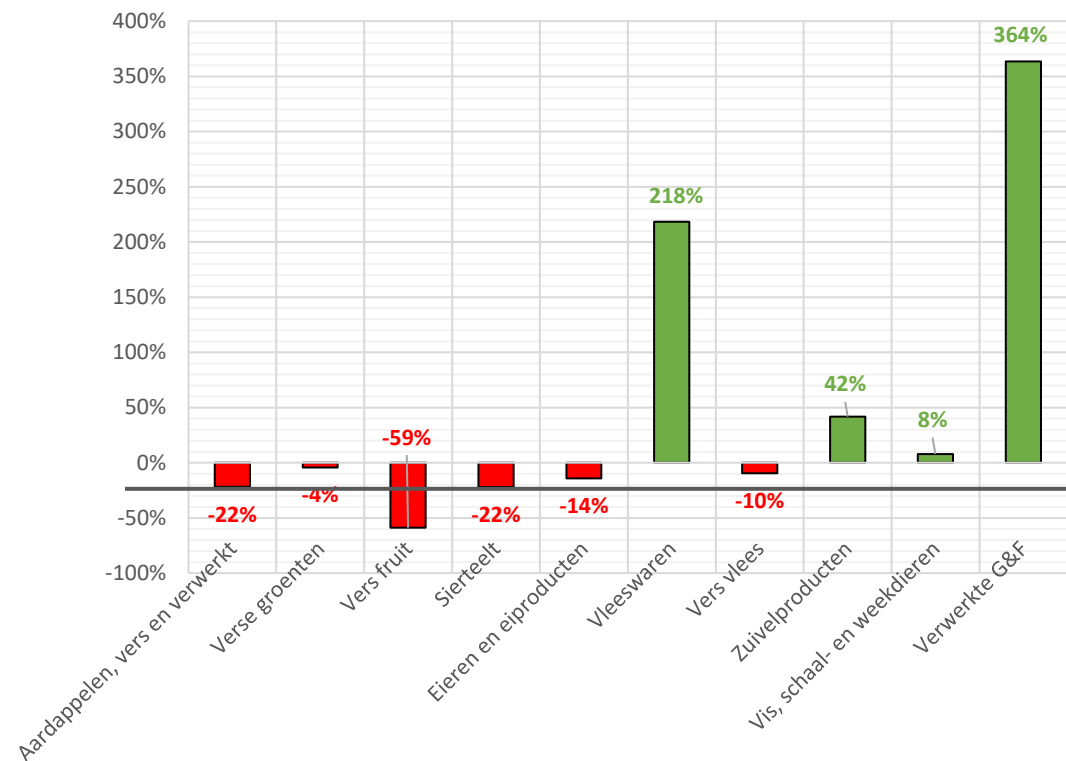
